The Full papers/short communications that are approved will be accompanied by ORAL PRESENTATION or POSTER (mandatory).

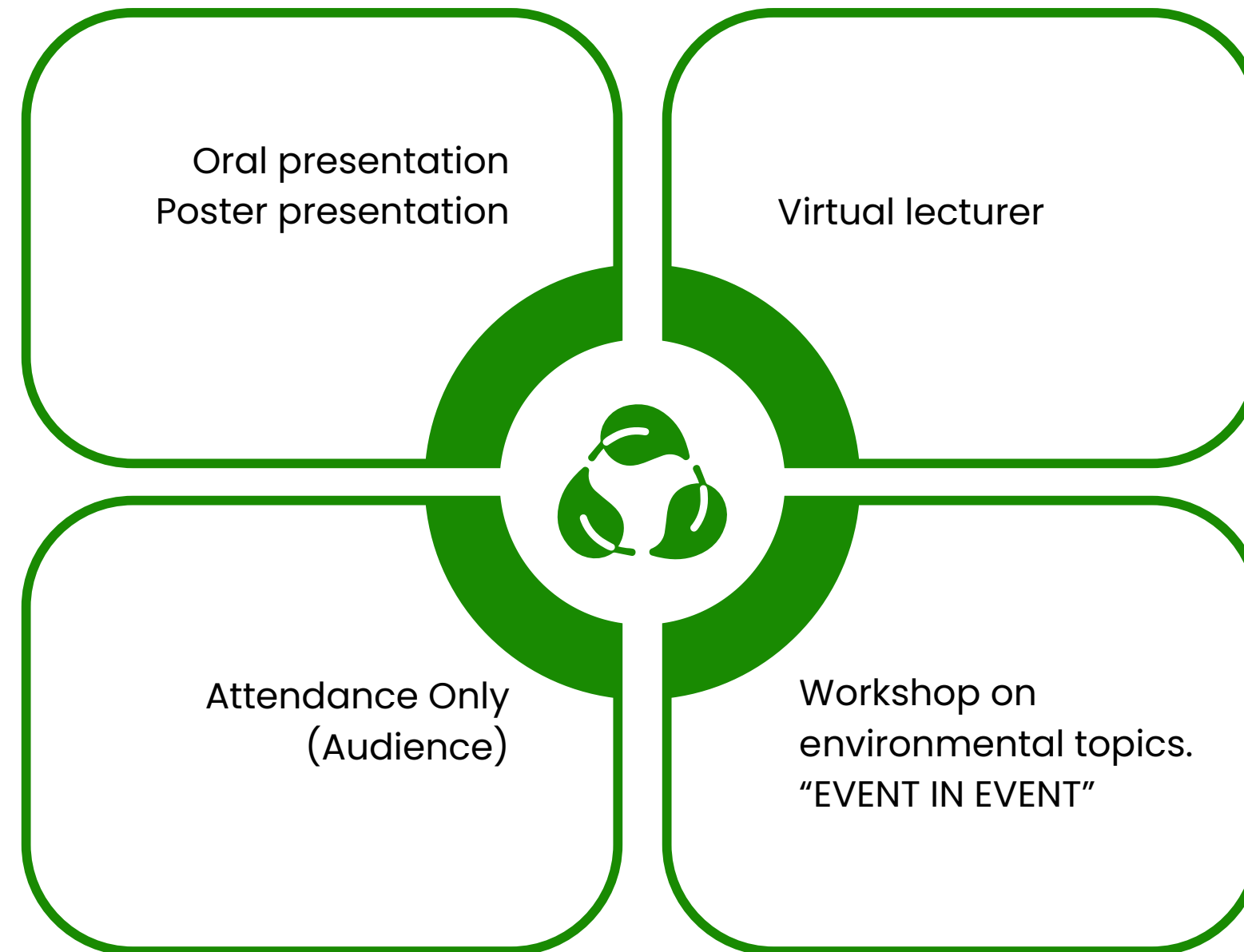
